**Happy Easter!** What a **huge deal** this is for us! It's **way better** than having a coupon ... Jesus paid the full price of our admission to the Eternal Banquet!

And **Jesus** did even more than that ...

He gave us everything we need to find our way to get to this Banquet.

Through **the Church** He established, **He gave us** access to His supernatural help in the Sacraments of **Baptism ... Confession ... Confirmation & Holy Communion.**

**St. Paul** tells us today in his letter to the **Romans**,

*“We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death,  
so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father,  
we too might live in newness of life.”*

**So Baptism** brings “**Newness of life**” ... **how wonderful** ...  
**who** doesn't want that ... **especially** as we get older?

Well, it's through **Baptism** that we begin to live in **newness of life** ...  
with the indwelling of **God's Holy Spirit** in us ...  
made possible by ... **the Death and Resurrection** of Christ.

And it's through the **other Sacraments** **Jesus** gave us ... that we **get to** repair and  
strengthen our relationship with God throughout our lives ...  
so that we stay on the road to arriving at **the Gates of Heaven**.

Well, **last night**, we welcomed **10 more people** who came to know this.

**After weeks of prayer and study**, those **10 people** recognize that
