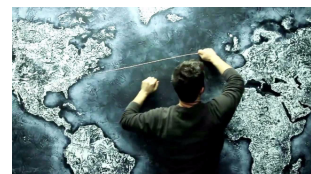
RECTORY OPEN HOUSE

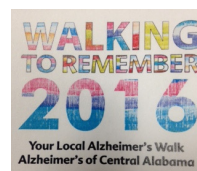
