One of our Parishioners who attended the 6:30 morning Mass on Monday came up to me after Mass and asked,

“So Father, what do you recommend I carry in my car?”

Her question came as a result of my homily that day, where I described how another Parishioner took the opportunity to evangelize by offering some things that they carry in their car.

You see, in leaving a restaurant Sunday afternoon where families had gathered to celebrate the First Communion of their children, Rod Cameron and I were thanking the Assistant Manager for the fine food and service when she happened to say, “I used to be Catholic”.

We hear this admission a lot these days ... and it's as if many people are crying out for a way to come back!

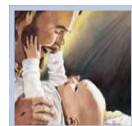
