We will begin our day with Mass, followed by several talks, confession, prayer throughout the day, and a Q&A session.

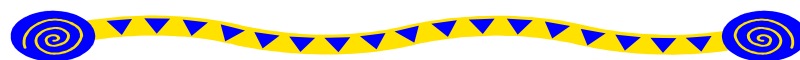

## YOUTH HAPPENINGS

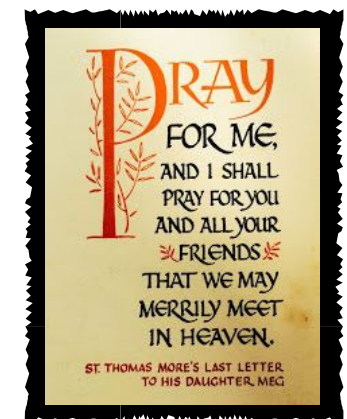
Be sure to check out the Remind group App and the bulletin for Summer events!
