If you did not pick up your 2018 envelopes call the Church office at 631-9398. If you use the Faith Direct method then you do not need envelopes—THANK YOU!!

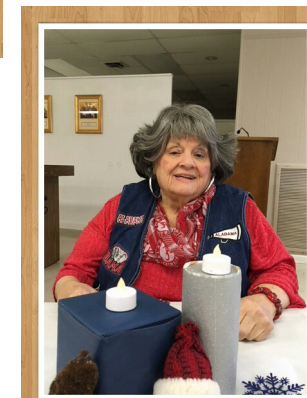
In order to get a 2017 Tax Exemption
