- II. **Evangelization:** Open wide the doors of Christ through missionary discipleship and personal encounter.
- III. **Religious Freedom:** Promote and defend the freedom to serve, witness and worship in the United States and abroad.
- IV. **Human Life and Dignity:** Uphold the sanctity and dignity of human life from conception to natural death.
- V. **Vocations:** Encourage vocations to the Priesthood and Consecrated Life and provide meaningful ongoing formation to Clergy, Religious and Lay Ministers.

Where is the Church going? This is where! These are the areas where the Holy Spirit is guiding the Church to focus Her efforts in the days and years ahead.

There were numerous "Specific Areas of Emphasis" listed for each category and much input was gathered from the Bishops present at this meeting. Now the Plans & Priorities Subcommittee will continue to assemble a document ... in keeping with the emphasis provided by our Holy Father, Pope Francis, so that they can present a more complete draft of the Plan when the Bishops gather again for their Fall Meeting.

Is it any surprise that **Family and Marriage** is the **#1 concern**? Just look at all the broken families, abused and neglected children, and couples living together without marriage and it's easy to see the devil is successfully dismantling our society.

Please pray for the continuing work of our Bishops ... and please pray for each of the above Priorities.
