LENTEN REGULATIONS

For Catholics: Fasting and Abstinence are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fast and Abstinence. All other Fridays during Lent are days of Abstinence.

During Lent, St. Henry Stations of the Cross takes place on Wednesdays at 5:45pm and followed by Mass at 6:00pm.
