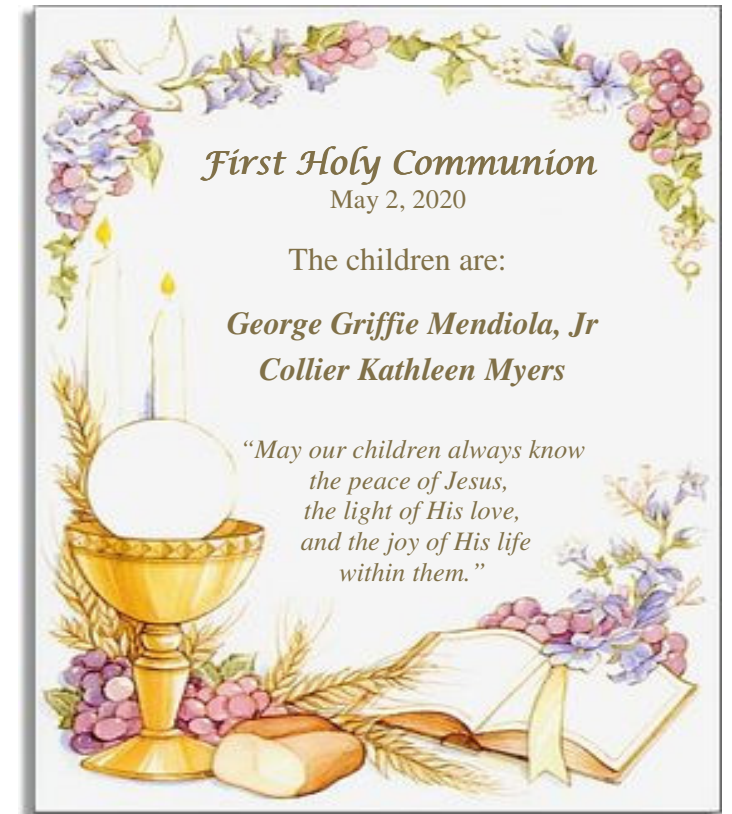
SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION
